Jones Attends Greenbelt Awards Honouring Caledon's Dixie Orchards

(Queen's Park) –Sylvia Jones, MPP (Dufferin-Caledon) attended the fifth anniversary of the Friends of the Greenbelt Award Ceremony at the Royal Ontario Museum, where Paul Gray of Dixie Orchards in Caledon was honoured.

Dixie Orchards was nominated by Eco-Source, an environmental education organization based in Peel region. Gray was presented this award by Hon. William Davis, a previous Friends of the Greenbelt Award recipient.

“Dixie Orchards is wonderful example of a farm that cares that for the land and feeds communities,” said Jones. “I was pleased to be able to share in the celebration.”

Dixie Orchards is a family owned and operated apple farm that provides the community with eleven different kinds of apples, raspberries and fresh baked pies. During the apple season, they offer wagon rides, a corn maze, bakery, pumpkins and seasonal decorations.

Gray and Dixie Orchards was one of the five honourees from across the Greenbelt. Ontario's Greenbelt is a 1.8 million acre area of permanently protected green space, farmland, forests, wetlands, and watersheds.
